This 12-month, full-time, fixed-term appointment is through the Cooperative Institute for Marine Resources Studies working on a joint OSU/NOAA GLOBEC study of the northeast Pacific under the direction of Dr. Thomas Wainwright and other affiliated principal investigators. This study addresses food web structure and dynamics of the California current system, with a focus on trophic relationships of salmon. There will be ample opportunity to develop an independent research project. The position is located at the OSU Hatfield Marine Science Center in Newport, OR. Reappointment is at the discretion of the CIMRS Director.
