To access WHOI via your ISP, you need to have a RAS account. If you don't have a RAS account one will be set up and the information sent to you in a different document. If you have already been assigned a RAS account, please use the same username and password for your VPN access.

You can find the Windows client and the setup instructions for the VPN client at the WHOI FTP site with the following URL: <ftp://ftp.who.edu/pub/services/vpn/>. Or, if you would prefer, you can pick up a loaner CD containing the software from the CIS Helpdesk.

The client setup instructions that you retrieve from the WHOI FTP site will have 3 numbered areas in the document that refer to the information below. This information should be used when setting up your VPN client.

1. Host to connect to is: **128.128.250.27**
2. Group name = **who** (*case sensitive*)
3. Pswd = **who1930** (*case sensitive*)

For your own protection, CIS strongly advises you to always have virus protection software running on your computer with up to date virus definitions. CIS also recommends you install firewall protection on your home computer. For Windows95/98/Me/NT/2000/XP, ZoneAlarm from <http://zonelabs.com/> is free for personal and nonprofit use.
