The University of Connecticut's Department of Marine Sciences is recruiting for a Postdoctoral Fellow in molecular systematics of marine zooplankton, including molecular species identification, phylogeography, and phylogeny. Expertise with standard molecular genetic procedures is required, including DNA and RNA purification, PCR, primer design, cloning, DNA sequencing, and data analysis. The postdoctoral advisor is Ann Bucklin, Professor of Marine Sciences, and the position is located at the Marine Science and Technology Center on the Avery Point Campus. This is a one year grant-funded position subject to annual renewal. Funding is through the Census of Marine Zooplankton (see <http://www.CMarZ.org>), a new field project of the Census of Marine Life (CoML). Position will become available on September 1, 2005. Applications received by July 31st will receive full consideration.
